ZTL = ZONA TRAFFICO LIMITATO: Restricted Traffic Area

- In this area only residents with a Local Police permit are allowed to drive within.
- Non-residents need to be authorized by police if are to drive in that area for official or specific reasons (meetings, weddings, ...).
- Standing and ground signs are posted warning drivers about the limitation.

2. PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION. Starting March 28th new itineraries for the CENTROBUS were introduced:
- Line # 30 will continue onto Contra' delle Canove with a new stop at Contra' S. Corona
 - Line # 10 will have a new stop at Teatro Olimpico

SOME TIPS...

- Be advised that all around the ZTL several cameras are installed all around the perimeter and if you cross, not authorized, the restricted area, you'll be fined each time you pass by any camera. That would result in multiple tickets on the same day.
- Due to the fact that our vehicles hold cover plates that are nationally registered in Rome, it could take a few weeks to the Local Police before they identify the vehicle's owner. Therefore don't feel safe if don't receive the ticket the next day...
- In case of infractions that prescribe reduction of points from your driver license, you have to let the Local Police know who was driving the vehicle within 60 days from the notification of the ticket
- You may be entitled to 30% discount if you pay your ticket within 5 days from its notification, except the cases that prescribe your driving license be suspended.
